

MASTERS PAYOUT INSTRUCTIONS

Our second pool of the year and our first major of the year looked like a runaway for defending champ Rory McIlroy at the halfway point. That changed radically as the field bunched up on Saturday. Rory prevailed in the Sunday finish to successfully defend his title. However, high scores by several of the major contenders again completely scrambled the pool standings on the final day. Shane Lowry's 80 on Sunday knocked the overall pool leader after round 3 completely out of the money.

The overall winner was CHMS08 with the combo of McIlroy, birthday boy Henley, and Homa at -30. ThunderUp 13 and WIZZ-18 tied for second place at -28. RAW13 was 4th at -27 and FallonBoy09 was 5th at -26. They were followed by a massive ten way tie for 6th place at among #Amen2That04, Ball Fore 01, FallonBoy23, Fold11, Jsary2, JVF-10, Kate 22, Kruz12, Kruz16, and MikeRoss01. Fold10 captured THE CARLOS with the unusually low total of +16. Daily winners included Triple Mulligans23 (Thursday), Cuttbait12/HOTRODS09 (Friday), FallonBoy23 (Saturday), and YetiQQ (Sunday).

The pool turnout was back to normal for the Masters with a total of 1,006 entries. (We discovered one invalid entry with only two different players and granted a refund.) The 1,006 entries produced a prize pool of \$20,120. After the deduction of \$3600 (dailies, the CARLOS, fixed awards for positions 6 through 10) we were left with \$16,520. This money was divided \$8260/2800/2800/1660/1000 for the first five places. The ten players tying for 6th place received either \$220 or \$200 depending on a lottery draw.

Of the winners listed below all except one are amenable to payment by check or at least one of the online services. I have tried to match the checks only second place finisher with as many people who prefer to pay by check but didn't have quite enough of them. As usual, some of the cashers aren't shown in the instructions below as they won only enough to reduce what they owe. Those in that category include Yeti, Triple Mulligans, and HOTRODS. Four other cashers (Kruz, Fold11, Ball Fore, and MikeRoss) made small profits that I will pay from my numerous losing entries and funds from prepaid entries.. They don't appear below in the instructions. This leaves a small group of only four major winners in the instructions below.

If you are paying by Paypal, I don't include complete instructions any longer as they keep making changes. The most important thing is that when the screen comes up after you enter the payment amount, MAKE SURE that it says "Sending to a friend". If it doesn't say that click on the "Change" icon and fix it. Also, it's not as easy to make Comments now. You have to click on the line that says "What's this payment for". It then makes space to add your comment. We still want you to add the entry name you played under as a Comment. You should also be very careful to correctly enter the Paypal id. We have had instances where a typo was accepted by Paypal and left as "unclaimed" until cancelled. **Do not use the word "Pool" in your comment or anything else to suggest gambling payments are involved.**

If you are paying by Venmo, it may ask you to enter the phone number of the recipient before making the payment. You can ignore this instruction. If you scroll down the

screen a little you will find an icon saying "Pay without confirming." Click on that to complete the payment.

Those paying by check should include their entry name in the memo portion of the check or in an accompanying note. This helps the winners keep track of the payments received. If paying by Paypal or Venmo ONLY enter your entry name in the comment/what's this for box ...nothing else.
